PROFESSIONAL LEARNING FOR SCHOOL LEADERS



Monthly Coaching - Each ASLA lead principal is paired with an Alaska-based, seasoned principal who has been trained to serve as a professional mentor. Coaches meet with their mentees two times a month online, via phone or in-person when feasible. Assistant Principals meet monthly as a cohort with a professional leadership coach. Sessions are personalized to focus on leadership issues and problems of practice participants face in their schools.



Face to Face Meetings - ASLA participants take part in three in-person meetings throughout the year.
